



SYNOPSIS

Southeast Asia has become a staging ground for a major powerplay between the Superpowers. When the soviets decide to establish a secret missile base, the Americans counter with a clandestine operation to stop them. There is only one man for the job. Brian O'Rilley, who like his partner, White Tiger, is a member of the elite "American Force", a small group of highly skilled freelance commandos who stand ready to use their specialized talents in the cause of freedom wherever and whenever they are needed by their country.
